The award is made to Insight because the company's financial performance was analysed and found to be in the top 1,000 businesses in Singapore.


The analysis, which is carried out by the independent and respected DP Information Group, is part of the annual "Singapore 1,000 & SME 1,000" survey and rankings.

To find the top companies each year, an independent DP Information Group research team measures the performance of Singapore incorporated businesses.
